As part of our work to promote the forthcoming admissions process, we have developed [graphics](#) which you may wish to use during your communication with parents, including at Open Night/Day events.

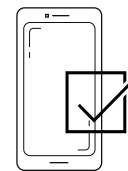
The graphics can be shared on your social media and web channels, or included in any other communications you may use within your school community.
